Scientific-institutional Symposium:

Health challenges brought to Africa by the **impoverishment of health systems**, the resurgence of **endemic diseases** or **those that were considered eradicated** and that may become a real threat even to high income countries. To address these challenges, we will also look at how **scientific dissemination**, **skills transfer and the grounding of disinfection practices** can be part of the solution. In this context, the impact of the difficulties in operating in extremely diverse cultural and social environments must be taken into account.

Results achieved by **transferring skills** in **hygiene training** and **protocols** and improving **procedures for sanitizing** surfaces, equipment, environments, hands, food and water in order to **prevent the spread of pandemics and diseases**.

Presentation and examination of some **case histories**: interventions carried out in several African countries with **NaCLO30 devices**, which demonstrate that the practice of disinfection is to be considered an indispensable necessity for the health safety of local populations.

Country Focus - Guinea Bissau: starting from this edition we aim to examine the social and health conditions of individual African countries. This year we will try to concretely analyse the health challenges posed to the **"Country System" of Guinea Bissau.**

On the sidelines, we will discuss how the resurgence of **Tuberculosis** is a real challenge or threat today and we also present a special case history dedicated to **Ukraine**.
